Preview: Bees looking to end losing streak in Matinee with Nashua

In the midst of a seven-game losing streak that's seen New Britain fall from second place to seventh in the FCBL, the 5-9 Bees are praying they can use home field advantage to stop the



skid. They'll get that chance Sunday, June 13 as they host the Nashua Silver Knights at New Britain Stadium in front of a crowd desperate for a Bees victory.

New Britain was naturally excited when they busted out to a 5-2 start to the season, but the past seven games have seen things go from bad to worse for the Bees. They have been mercy-ruled twice in the stretch and have been outscored 16-1 in their past two games. That won't stop head coach Donnie McKillop from staying upbeat however.
