Preview: Bees looking to rebound from 11-0 loss in rematch with Brockton

Saturday's 11-0 home loss to the Brockton Rox in the teams' first meeting of the season wasn't pretty for New Britain. But, luckily for the Bees, they won't have to wait long to put the



defeat behind them. This Sunday, June 6 the Bees will face the Rox again, looking to exact their revenge on the diamond.
