

Preview: Bees seek third straight win as they face the Rox in Brockton



Wednesday, June 16 the 7-9 New Britain Bees will be on the road to challenge the first place Brockton Rox. The Bees have now won two straight games after losing seven in a row previously. They will have a chance to win their third straight game.

The Bees are certainly hoping to extend their current winning streak to three games, but defeating Brockton is no small task. The Rox are 11-4 and sit in first place in the FCBL, coming off a double-header sweep over the Worcester Bravehearts.

These teams have met twice before, but those games were part of a weekend to forget for New Britain. In back-to-back games, the Bees fell 11-0 and 4-3 to the Rox, which was the beginning of their seven-game losing streak. Brockton's Michael Golankiewicz, who leads the FCBL in batting average (.438) and home runs (three), was particularly excellent in those games. He collected six hits and six RBI's in the two-game set.

The Bees counter to Golankiewicz and the Rox offense will be Dawson Logie, who is coming off his best start of the season. Logie has improved in each of his first three starts, including his most recent where he allowed only two runs in seven innings. Hopefully for New Britain Logie will be able to continue building a strong season on Wednesday.

The game will begin at 6:00 p.m. Eastern.
